Basics

-  Exchange a 4-figure code (5820) by video
-  Reports and Locators by any other means
-  Claim Points per kilometre
-  All bands 432 MHz up




Roving

-  Stations are encouraged to "Rove"
-  Move over 5 km
-  Start a new entry with new serials codes and logs
-  Ask duplicate stations to use a second code
-  Points get added together at the end

-  Submit Logs to your National Coordinator
-  He should submit them to me 3 weeks later
