

- 61 repeater streaming channels




On line presence

A good way to get around this is to not use a satellite receiver but just the minitiouner with 12V to the LNB, rotate the LNB by 90 degrees and log

This may also help http://www.groundcontrol.com/Satellite_... ulator.htm

As the UK longitude 26 degrees west of the satellite, polarisation is tilted too, it is going to be practically the same as for 28E so the standard LNE does not allow excel files so it is a zip.

Contests



- We are trying to encourage members to "get on the air"
 - There is a real danger of "use it or lose it"
 - Ofcom DO monitor activity
 - Get on air and tell everyone about it
- BATC activity weekends to focus activity
 - We need your input to improve them
- It does work!
 - Zero UK entries in 2015 IARU region 1 contest!
 - 11 in 2016
 - 23 in 2017
 - 28 in 2018 more than any other country!!



BATC shop

- Shop policy is to make "hard to get parts" (only) available to members at lowest possible cost
- Shop is there to support members and encourage all forms of ATV activity
 - Not to make a profit but it does
- Portsdown ~280 builders
- 500+ Minituner parts sold!
- DTX1 Sold ~150 units at cost
 - No longer stocked
- New shop is more flexible
 - CAT18 tickets
 - Golf shirts





BATC bursary fund

- Grants of money available to individuals and groups to fund projects to benefit the ATV community
- Pump priming for development projects
 - Development tools / hardware, prototype PCBs
- One off funding for repeater groups
 - one off costs such as rebuilds or legal fees.
 - Will not fund ongoing annual fees
- ATV infrastructure
 - Es'hail-2 ground station project at Goonhilly
- Funding for Dxpeditions with an ATV interest.
- © Outreach support for ATV groups
 - Demo kit
 - ATV equipment for use by Radio Club members
- Applications welcome using the form on the website



Representing ATV

- RSGB spectrum forum
 - 146 MHz in the band plan!
 - RSGB supporting DATV at IARU level
 - ATV acknowledged as a the big innovator!
- Ofcom liaison
 - 146MHz and 71 MHz additional spectrum!
 - WRC 19 submission
- ETCC representation
 - Supporting & promoting ATV repeaters
 - 3.4 & 5.6 GHz New bands for repeaters

RSGB microwave committee

 Jointly promoting the use of spectrum above 1 GHz

European liaison

- Represented UK ATV at pan-European conference at HAMRADIO2018
- Meet with reps from 4 other countries to align strategy on 70cms and 1.3 GHz

The future of CAT




- BATC will continue to have a national convention with the BGM every 2 years
- Should we make alternate year events several smaller regional gatherings?
- Organised by the people in the region and supported by BATC
 - North East / Yorkshire / Lincs?
 - North West / Manchester / Wirral?
 - Midlands / Telford?
 - South West / Bristol?
- Will help to build ATV communities around the country

Repeaters

- Not a BATC responsibility but
 - G8GTZ is TV representative on ETCC
- Currently 43 licensed units
 - 8 licensed but never put on air!
 - 5 Licensed but not in service
- 1 new application
 - All TV repeaters require Primary User approval
 - Frustrating but out of our control
 - 3.4 GHz is "easy"
 - Just had 3 * 23cms units approved by Ofcom!
 - GB3EY after 4 years!
- Use them or lose them!

- To broaden the appeal of BATC

- Introduce and make ATV accessible to younger age groups
 - Engage through Social Media

- Our financial security is good and we have adequate reserves





Thanks Graham for many years of hard work dedicated to promoting ATV






Dave Mann BATC President

- Licensed as G30U0/T and transmitted analogue 405 line on 70cm.
 - John Tanners van early 1960's.
- Joined BATC in Spring 1958 age 18.
 - First CQTV was No: 36
- Appointed BATC membership secretary in early 1960's for a couple of years
- Became Secretary and Membership secretary again 10 years ago
- Stepped in as CQ-TV editor for 240
